RE: Pre-School Fee Increase September 2022

Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to you to inform you that we are having to apply a fee increase, effective from 1st September 2022.

In order for our Pre-School to remain viable and provide a long-term service for our community, we must increase our fees. Currently we charge less per hour than we are funded by the government to provide early years education and care. From September the hourly rate for Pre-School will increase from £3:50 to £4.40 per hour.

Our prices continue to be competitive and offer value for money with teacher led, high quality early years education and care delivered by a team of highly qualified, experienced early years practitioners. We appreciate that this may be difficult in the current economic climate, however we must at least match the local authority funding rate in order to remain sustainable. Without appropriate funding we would not be able to continue to offer the flexibility and high standards that you have come to expect of us.

The fees for Wrenthorpe Pre-School remain extremely good value when compared with other local providers, for example:

Our proposed increase will take our fees to: ± 13.20 per session, ± 46.20 for the full day (7:30 – 18:00) and includes breakfast, drinks and snacks. This remains the lowest priced group day care available in the area according to the information published by the local authority as detailed above.

We will apply a 10% discount when full day sessions are taken over 5 days.

From September places can be taken on a term time only basis or 51 weeks of the year; your child's funding can be stretched over the full year. Please speak to Vickey if you would like to take up this provision.
